## LSW's Norwegian adventure

The Last of the Summer Wind Band (LSW) was formed in 2008 when Gwyn Evans, Beaumaris Band musical director, returned from working with a Norwegian band. He was inspired by the way Norwegain bands involve whole families and the wider community in their set up.

Back in Beaumaris, just nine players joined Fred Evans for the first LSW rehearsal. Today, the band boasts 40 members — some are players that have picked up their instruments again after years of doing other things, others are learners from scratch.

As the band grew in numbers and confidence, they were invited to perform in concerts and competitions.

Earlier this year, LSW made its first overseas trip to compete in the Gubbiaden championships hosted by Stavanger Kommunes Korps – the band that first inspired Gwyn and Fred all those years ago! And to crown it all, they returned with the prize for the most entertaining performance!

"Establishing LSW has been one of the highlights of my 70 years in brass banding", says Fred. "It was such a pleasure to take the band to the city which sowed the seed for this adventure!"
