I'm delighted to congratulate Gwyn on receiving the prestigious Mortimer Medal during the National Brass Band Championships of Great Britain in the Royal Albert Hall in October.

The Mortimer Medal is awarded to members of the Brass Band community who are deemed to have made an outstanding contribution to Youth Bands and young musicians. When making the announcement Philip Morris, Chairman of the Worshipful Company of Musicians' Brass Band Committee said "Gwyn is one of the unsung heroes of Welsh youth brass band development."

We welcome Scott Lloyd as our new conductor of the senior band and Hefin Evans will guide the youth band while Gwyn concentrates his talents in the everstrengthening brass band movement in Norway.

Seindorf Beaumaris returned to the world of competitions recently as the Band competed in the Fourth Section of Rochdale's Festival of Brass on 21 October.

Many of us loyal followers of the band will remember starting on a similar journey way back in 1990 - let's hope for a similar successful journey for our current superb musicians.

On 10th October some of our players provided music for the RMS Leinster memorial service in Holyhead and the Band will be out in force for the Remembrance Day parade on 11th November.

On 3rd November we sent two competing bands to the North Wales Rally in Ruthin – and they did us proud as ever.

We will be holding a Christmas Fair in Beaumaris Town Hall on 1st December. Please give us your support as always.

I hope to see many of you at the Christmas concerts on 7th & 8th December.
